Our Standard Banners are manufactured from 13oz heavy-duty vinyl material utilizing the newest digital printing technology. Banners are very durable and will hold up well through several years of indoor or outdoor use. Banners have 1 year outdoor fade resistance and an indoor life expectancy of 5+ years. Banners are finished with a 1-inch hem and include metal grommets in the corners and spaced along the edges approximately every 24 inches. Additional finishing (pole pocket / rope hem / wind slits) is also available.

From Small to Large, Banners work in all types of spaces

Vinyl Banners / Items: SBS, SBM, SBL, SBXL

Use: Hang on wall, fence or from ceiling.

Media: 13 oz PVC Scrim Banner (1000 denier). NFPA701 Fire Rated.

Finishing: Welded hems and grommets standard.

Vinyl Banners / Items: SBS, SBM, SBL, SBXL

Wind Vents Option: Banner face is cut with several “half-moon” slits which create openings intended to lessen pressure on the banner caused by wind. This option does help the banner to withstand some measure of wind but will also lessen the overall life of the banner. Additional charges apply.



Pocket Option: Banners can be finished with an optional pocket instead of a standard hem. Designed for sliding a long rod through a “pocket” along the top and letting the banner hang. Pockets can be along one or two edges and must be specified at time of order. Additional charges apply.



Sizes available:

3” pocket (for rods up to 1” O.D.)

4” pocket (for rods up to 1-3/4” O.D.)

Reinforced Hem Heavy-Duty Option: Nylon webbing is welded into the banner hem to increase strength. Recommended for added safety and security over roadways or areas subject to windy conditions. Reinforced Hem must be specified at time of order. Additional charges apply.



Rope Leaders Option: Rope leaders are available in any length (5-foot length is most popular). Specify length and how many rope sections per banner will be required. Diamond braid multifilament rope has a break strength of approximately 400 pounds per inch. Additional charges apply.



Rolled for Shipping: Most banners (small, medium and large) are rolled for shipping. Any banner longer than 50 feet and all banners 7’ or larger (measured in the shortest direction) will be folded.



Banner Hanging Tips – Best Practices

If possible, choose a calm weather day to install your banner. If it’s windy or rainy, it is possible to secure the banner too loosely or the opposite – over tightening and pulling too hard on the banner can shorten the banner’s life. A properly installed banner has enough tension that there are no wrinkles in the media. The banner is fastened to a structure using all of the provided grommet locations.

On a Chain Link Fence

Due to their strength and affordability, heavy-duty zip ties are the preferred method for installing vinyl banners. One zip tie per grommet location and two zip ties in all corners recommended. As an alternate to zip ties, nylon rope or re-bar wire could be used instead.



When first connecting a banner with zip ties, only tighten enough to hold the banner in place while you move on to the next grommet. Once all the zip ties are in place, go back to each zip tie and tighten as needed so that there is a solid, uniform fit throughout the span of the

banner. The key is to distribute the stress across multiple points (top, bottom and sides), limiting the whipping action that can happen when the wind starts blowing (commonly seen on banners that are hung loosely and have slack to move). The whipping action is a flapping type of movement (like a flag rapidly waving in the wind) and this is movement will shorten the life of the banner.

Maintenance

Regular inspection of the banner is important. Tighten any connections that have loosened or replace any connections that may have broke. This will maintain a professional look and will help ensure the banner lasts.

Cleaning Vinyl Banners

Gently wipe banner with a clean and damp, soft cloth. If soap is needed use a mild, non-detergent cleaner. Rinse to remove any soap residue. Be sure banner is dry before storing. DO NOT use any abrasive cleaning pads or use any solvents or harsh chemical cleaners.

Storing Vinyl Banners

Be sure your banner is dry before storing. Roll your banner (print-side in) then store in a clean, dry, indoor location away from direct sunlight.
